





Songs should not contain any profanity or hurt any religious sentiments, caste, or community.
Play Back	 Theme: Solo/Duet/Group Karaoke singing with muted video in the background Time: 3+1 Minutes The judge's decision is final. The participant will be judged on Pitch, Clarity, Rhythm, emotion, and Range. Exceeding the time limit will result in losing points. No instruments allowed. Max 4 members can be allowed in a group song. Songs or videos should not contain any profanity or hurt any religious

sentiments, caste, or community.

Medley	 Theme: Solo/Duet/Group (Medley of vernacular and English songs) Time: 3+1 Minutes The judge's decision is final. The participant will be judged on Pitch, Clarity, Rhythm, and Range. Exceeding the time limit will result in losing points. Instruments are allowed. Max 4 members can be allowed in a group song. Songs should not contain any profanity or hurt any religious sentiments, caste, or community.
Instrumental	 Theme: Solo Time: 2+1 Minutes The judge's decision is final. The participants will be judged based on Rhythm, Melody, Harmony, and Timing. Exceeding the time limit will result in losing points. All Instruments are allowed. A drum kit will be provided by the college. Other instruments will not be provided. Backing track is allowed.
Beat Boxing	 Time: 1 Minute 30 Seconds Beat Boxing Criteria -Musicality, Technicality, Clarity, Originality and Stage Presence. The judge's decision is final. Exceeding the time limit will result in losing points.

The evaluation will be made based on content, coverage, facts, writing spirit inclined towards the topic, and logical presentation with due rationale. The decision of the Jury shall be final & binding on all the participants. 	
Versification Poetry Writing Competition)	 Time Limit: 1 Hour Poems must be in English only. Themes will be given by the committee on the spot. The decision of the jury shall be final& binding on all the participants. 	

• The topic shall be given on the spot by the judges. • The contestants shall be given 2 minutes to prepare and 2 + 1 minutes to deliver. • The contestants are not allowed to use any gadgets. **Extempore** • The style of the delivery shall be oratorical. • Dramatic style is considered disqualified. • The judges' decision is final. 
