Annual Report of IQAC for the Academic Year 2016-17

Faculty Development Program: During the academic year 2016-17 two FDPs were conducted. During the odd semester a two-day faculty development program was organized by St. Claret College on June 27-28, 2016 at Christ University, Bangalore. The program aimed at acquainting teachers with the new methods and techniques of teaching. Dr. (Fr) Thomas C Mathew, Vice Chancellor, Christ University, welcomed the teachers and exhorted them to develop strategies to foster Human values in the students and internalize the mission and vision of St. Claret College. Various other topics were discussed like: Academic audit, Professional learning in Teaching profession, Education in the changing world, how to become a Brilliant Mentor? Using Technology in classrooms, and On Followership. These sessions helped the teachers to understand the need of the hour to change from traditional classroom settings to technology savvy places. During the even semester a two-day faculty development program was conducted on March 24-25, 2017 at St. Claret College. The program was conducted by Rev. Dr. Sabu George, Principal and included interactive sessions on Strategic Planning for Academic Excellence, Followership, Use of ICT, Skills Gap of Faculty and Students, Goals of the college 2020-25 and improving students' participation in class. In his keynote address Dr. Fernandez, spoke on the importance of start-ups and the value of entrepreneurship in developing the economy of the nation. The conference started on a great note with technical sessions and panel discussions by eminent academicians and distinguished members from the industry.
