Annual Report IQAC 2018-19

Inauguration of the new Academic Year 2018-2019.

The Twelfth Academic year of St. Claret College was inaugurated on June 26, 2018. The program was presided over by Rev. Dr. Sabu George, Principal, St. Claret College. The day began with a prayer and the ceremonious lighting of the lamp. The chief Guest of the day was Rev. Dr. George Kannanthanam, - rector, Project Vision, Bengaluru, who, in his note, addressed the students and exhorted them to realize that education is the most powerful weapon to change the world. He also laid special emphasis on developing values like honesty, efficiency, operation, gratitude and discipline.

12th Investiture Ceremony

The Investiture ceremony of St. Claret College was held on July 21, 2018. The chief guest of the day was Dr. Venugopal K R, Vice Chancellor, Bangalore University. The occasion was also graced by the other dignitaries: Rev. Fr. Joseph Mathew, Administrator, St. Claret Group of Institutions; Rev. Dr. Sabu George, Principal; Rev. Fr. Vineeth George, Vice Principal; Rev. Fr. Hridayaraj Professor of Bharathanatyam and Ms. Maria D'Souza, the Staff Coordinator. The ceremonial investiture march was led by the members of the Student Core Council: College Captains - Mr. Sanketh and Ms. Gaadha, Cultural Captains - Mr. Mohith and Ms. Mymika and Sport Captains - Mr. Naveen and Ms. Sanjana, followed by the representatives of the various clubs, associations and class leaders. 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Role of Entrepreneurship and Digitalization stressed at National Conference of St. Claret College

St Claret College organized a one-day national conference ‘Thinking Local - Going Global: Entrepreneurship and Digitalization’ on November 13, 2018. Ms. Uma Reddy, Advisor, World Trade Centre was the chief guest and the keynote speaker. Ms. Uma outlined that being an entrepreneur requires lot of commitment, and one needs to know the managerial skills, as well as human skills such as persistence to overcome problems. One should also know who one’s competitors are and stay updated with the recent trends. Speaking on the occasion, Rev. Dr. Sabu George, Principal, St. Claret College, opined that entrepreneurship is a vocation that not many people take up owing to the challenges it poses, but immense success follows those who dare to defy and overcome those hurdles. Palanithurai, Rajiv Gandhi Chair Professor in the Department of Political Science at Gandhi Gram Rural Deemed University, Tamil Nadu; Mr. Mekin Maheshwari, Founder, Udhyam Foundation and Ms. Megha Abhijeet, Head, Transformation and Talent Head, Northern Trust. ‘Excelsior’, the annual magazine was also released during the conference. The conference was attended by over 100 delegates from across the country.

The two Parent-Teacher meets were held during the academic year 2018-19. The first meet during the odd Semester was held on September 29, 2018. Inauguration of Postgraduate (PG) Programs

St. Claret College inaugurated its PG Programs - Master of Social Work (MSW) and Master of Commerce (M. Com) on September 1, 2018. The chief guest Dr. R Sarvamangala, Associate Professor, Bangalore University along with the Guest of Honor, Rev.Fr.Benny Mathew, Manager, St. Claret Group of Institutions, Ms. Seema Joseph, PG Coordinator and Ms. Maria D’Souza, Staff Coordinator inaugurated the event. In the welcome address, Rev. Fr. Benny Mathew briefed the students about the significance of PG studies and urged them to be responsible students by being



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a role model for their juniors in the campus.
