#### NIRF & Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIIA) 2022

The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) was approved by the MHRD and launched by Honorable Minister of Human Resource Development on 29th September 2015. This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception".

Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) is an initiative of Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India to systematically rank all major higher educational institutions and universities in India on indicators related to "Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development" amongst students and faculties. HEIs should have a comprehensive and functional mechanism to convert research into innovations. This ecosystem will encourage, inspire and nurture young students by exposing them to new ideas and processes resulting in innovative. activities in their formative years.

St. Claret College has submitted the necessary documents for NIRF and ARIIA for institutional level ranking.

#### **IQAC Special Initiative**

- Academic and Administrative Audits: Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) is the process of evaluating the efficiency and effectiveness of an academic institution. The college conducts AAA at regular intervals to review the programmes and academic activities in the departments and in the institution. AAA was conducted from July 25-30 2022.

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#### Value Week Day 5:


#### **Synergic Cooperation**

#### **Intellectual Competence**



#### Workshop on SCC Strength Analysis



#### Workshop on SCC Weakness, Opportunity & Challenges Analysis



#### Workshop on Revised Internal Assessment



#### HR Summit 2022



#### Holi Celebration



#### MOU with University of Professional Studies Accra (UPSA), Ghana






#### SHUBHAARAMBH 2021




