## IQAC Initiatives and Practices

### 1. Session on campus culture

#### **Initiative**

Orientation for new students joining during this academic year was conducted to make them aware about the Vision, Mission, Core Values of the College and to know more about the clubs and associations, roles and responsibilities, campus discipline, mentoring, etc so as to enable them to know about the culture of the institution.

#### **Outcome**

On 8th July 2017, Orientation program for newly joined students were conducted covering the following topics:

- Vision, Mission and Core values
- Introduction about various Clubs and Associations
- Grooming and Discipline
- Mentoring
- Attendance aspects
- EC & CC information
- Various scholarships details
- Counselling services available

### 2. Internal Audits

#### **Initiative**

Evaluation plays an important role in smooth running of an organisation. It helps the employees to evaluate their work objectively and work on the shortcomings, if any. Hence, IQAC advised the departments and clubs to take up internal audits twice in an academic year.

#### **Outcome**

As a part of improving the academic and performance of the institution, IQAC conducted internal audit of all the departments, clubs and associations at the end of both the semesters of the academic year to evaluate the performances.



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### 3. Skill enhancement program (SEP)

#### Initiative

SEP classes were conducted for first and second-year students in order to help students to make matured decisions, communicate effectively and develop coping with self-management skills that help them to lead a healthy and productive life. These social and emotional skills helped our students to mould themselves from childhood to adulthood.

#### Outcome

SEP classes were conducted in odd and even semesters of this academic year for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students to bridge the gap between Pre-University and Under Graduate learning covering topics like personal grooming, social etiquettes, intercultural sensitivity, goal setting, media influence, need to forgive, handling jealousy, maintaining good relationships. The classes for 1<sup>st</sup> year students were conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2017 -11<sup>th</sup> July 2017, 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2018 and 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2018. For 2<sup>nd</sup> year students the classes were also conducted on July 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> 2017, March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2018, April 13<sup>th</sup> 2018.

### 4. Financial support for faculty attending Conference, Workshops

#### Initiative

Effective teachers are open to students' ways of being imaginative and also utilize many approaches to learning. Students appreciate and are personally motivated when teachers design lessons that consider their interests, skills, and needs. It is proposed to provide financial assistance to encourage faculty to attend conferences and workshops.

#### Outcome

A total of 48 faculties attended conferences and workshops during the academic year taking financial support for reimbursing the amount from the institution spent by the faculty

### 5. Professional Development Programme (PDP)

#### Initiative

Professional development programs help to enhance analytical, problem solving and thinking skills among individuals. To keep the faculty fraternity reviving their skills and commitment towards the institutional development and growth various kinds of PDP's and sessions were organised during the academic year.

- Department of languages conducted a intra collegiate student paper presentation on Basavanna and Kanakadasa on 1<sup>st</sup> march 2018

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## 11. CCTV installation in classroom

### Initiative

IQAC proposed to install CCTV camera in classrooms as a measure to prevent thievery and make students feel safe.

### Outcome

CCTV cameras were installed inside classrooms in the year 2017. They were required in order to make students feel safe and prevent thievery.

## 12. Installation of Projectors in Classrooms

### Initiative
