1. Student Orientation Program

Initiative

Outcome

2. New Faculty orientation program

Initiative

3. Investiture

Initiative

Outcome

The office bearers of the Student Core Council members were instituted into their positions and molding them to be future leaders who take their roles and responsibilities seriously.

4. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Survey (MHRD Flagship Program)

Initiative

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is inspired by the vision of transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an Inclusive India. In this regard St. Claret College had adopted 5 villages in the surrounding areas and the first step of this process is survey.

Outcome:

The household survey in the adopted villages was successfully completed on 10th Aug 2019 by the student volunteers of St. Claret College under the supportive supervision of faculty and staff of St. Claret College. A total of 2900 households were covered on the day in four villages. A total of 749 students, supervised by 45 faculty/staff of St. Claret College, had conducted the village survey. The survey was conducted in 4 villages namely Dasanapua, Hellegowdanahalli, Byregowdanahalli, Sondekoppa and Lakenahalli

5. Establishment of Institution's Innovation Council

Initiative

Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India has established 'MoE's Innovation Cell (MIC)' to systematically foster the culture of Innovation amongst all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). The primary mandate of MIC is to encourage, inspire and nurture young students by supporting them to work with new ideas and transform them into prototypes while they are in formative years.

Outcome:

St. Claret College established Institution's Innovation Council (IICs) in the academic year 2019-20 to promote innovation and entrepreneurship in the Institution through multitudinous modes leading to an innovation promotion ecosystem in the campuses. Under Institution's Innovation Council, several programs were conducted such as Ideation workshop, Entrepreneurship training program, sessions on IP and etc.

6. Establishment of SCC-KSCST IP Cell Initiative

Two days faculty development program was conducted on Significance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Innovations by Industry Academia Cell, St. Claret College in association with Karnataka State Council for Science Technology (KSCST), Indian Institute of Science, on 19th December 2019 - 20th December 2019.

Outcome

The primary objective of the program was to create awareness about IPRs, to help in patent searches, to know the process of filing of patent applications and to identify patent agents/attorneys. The secondary objective was to inaugurate the SCC-KSCST Intellectual Property Cell as well as signing the MOU with KSCST.

7. NPTEL

Initiative

NPTEL (National Program on Technology Enhanced Learning), is a joint venture of the IITs and IISc, funded by the Ministry of Education (MoE) Government of India. Initially started as a project to take quality education to all corners of the country.

Outcome

St. Claret College has been signed with IIT Madras to facilitate the NPTEL platform for faculty and students. The following faculty have completed different courses and certified from various IIT.
