Initiative

Outcome

NIRF & Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIIA) 2022 Initiative

The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) was approved by the MHRD and launched by Honorable Minister of Human Resource Development on 29th September 2015. This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception".

Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) is an initiative of Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India to systematically rank all major higher educational institutions and universities in India on indicators related to "Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development"

amongst students and faculties. HEIs should have a comprehensive and functional mechanism to convert research into innovations. This ecosystem will encourage, inspire, and nurture young students by exposing them to new ideas and processes resulting in innovative. activities in their formative years.

Outcome

St. Claret College has submitted the necessary documents for NIRF and ARIIA for institutional level ranking.

Academic and Administrative Audits

Initiative

Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) is the process of evaluating the efficiency and effectiveness of an academic institution. The college conducts AAA at regular intervals to review the programmes and academic activities in the departments and in the institution. AAA was conducted from July 25-30 2022.

Outcome

IQAC conducted AAA from July 25-30 2022 to streamline documentation process and check the completion of benchmarks of the departments.

Benchmarks

Initiative

IQAC promoted the push for Institutional Benchmarks for various departments and bodies within the institution in accordance with the notification received from NAAC.

Outcome

IQAC conducted sessions to empower departments to develop their own benchmarks.

Personal Plan of Action

Initiative

Outcome

The program saw over 100+ students participating in the virtual visit and taking away great learning.

Lighthouse: Molding Future Torchbearers (Leadership Building in Higher Education)

Initiative

IQAC organized a Leadership Building in Higher Education for the Student Councils on 22 December 2021, the resource person was Mr. Sonykutty George from UNICEF and it was conducted under the banner id UNAI. Workshop on SCC SWOC Analysis

Initiative

IQAC organized a workshop on identifying the strengths of the institution on February 22 2022. The session was headed by the Principal, Rev. Dr. Thomas Thennadiyil. The session involved gathering the faculty and brainstorming on the possible strengths of the institution, the biggest strength that was identified was the idea of SCC Cares. Initiative
