Day & Date	Events	Events
DAY 1 (Mon, Aug 10)	1. JAM (JUST A MINUTE) Format: Individual (60s stage challenge) - Speak on a given topic without Hesitation, Repetition, or Deviation. - Opponents challenge rule breaks live on stage to claim time and points. Venue: AV 1, Admin Block	2. MOVIE REVIEW Format: Individual (45 minutes writing time) . - Watch an on-spot short film and write a critical evaluation of its story and themes . - Focus on critical analysis and storytelling (writing sheets provided at venue). Venue: Room No. 225, Annex Block
DAY 2 (Tue, Aug 11)	3. BOOK TALK Format: Individual (Strict 2-minute limit) . - Pitch your favorite book passionately to convince the audience and judges to read it . - No slides or props permitted; focus on vocal presentation while avoiding major plot spoilers. Venue: AV 1, Admin Block	4. COLLAGE MAKING Format: Teams of 2 (45 minutes duration) . - Create a visual art collage based on an on-spot theme announced at the venue . - Bring your own chart paper, newspapers, magazines, scissors, and glue (no pre-cut materials). Venue: Seminar Hall, Annex Block
DAY 3 (Wed, Aug 12)	5. SPELL BEE Format: Individual (Oxford / British English standard) . - Round 1 consists of an on-spot written vocabulary dictation test for all participants . - Round 2 features live oral spelling and vocabulary knockout rounds. Venue: Seminar Hall, Annex Block	6. PRODUCT AD & SLOGAN WRITING Format: Individual (45 minutes duration) . - Write a catchy slogan and short persuasive ad pitch for a given product or idea . - Evaluated on brand creativity, persuasive copywriting, and clever marketing appeal. Venue: AV 1, Admin Block

DAY 4 (Thu Aug 13)	7. ELOCUTION (BEST READER) Format: Individual (Sight-reading challenge) . - Read unseen literary passages aloud on stage with clear expression and vocal modulation . - Passages provided at venue with 2 minutes quiet preparation time before stage reading. Venue: AV 1, Admin Block	8. WRITING COMIC STRIP Format: Team of 2 (45 minutes duration) . - Create an original 4 to 6-panel comic strip based on an on-spot prompt . - Drawing sheets provided; participants must bring their own stationery and colors. Venue: Seminar Hall, Annex Block
DAY 5 (Fri, Aug 14)	9. DEBATE Format: Team of 5 (3 min presentation + 2 min rebuttal) . - Argue FOR or AGAINST an on-spot. 10 minutes quiet prep time provided (mobile phones strictly prohibited). 2 rounds in total. Venue: AV 1, Admin Block	10. POP CULTURE & LIT QUIZ Format: Teams of 2 (Multi-round trivia showdown) . - Test your knowledge across literature, cinema, memes, music, tech, and trends . 3 rounds in total. Venue: Seminar Hall, Annex Block
