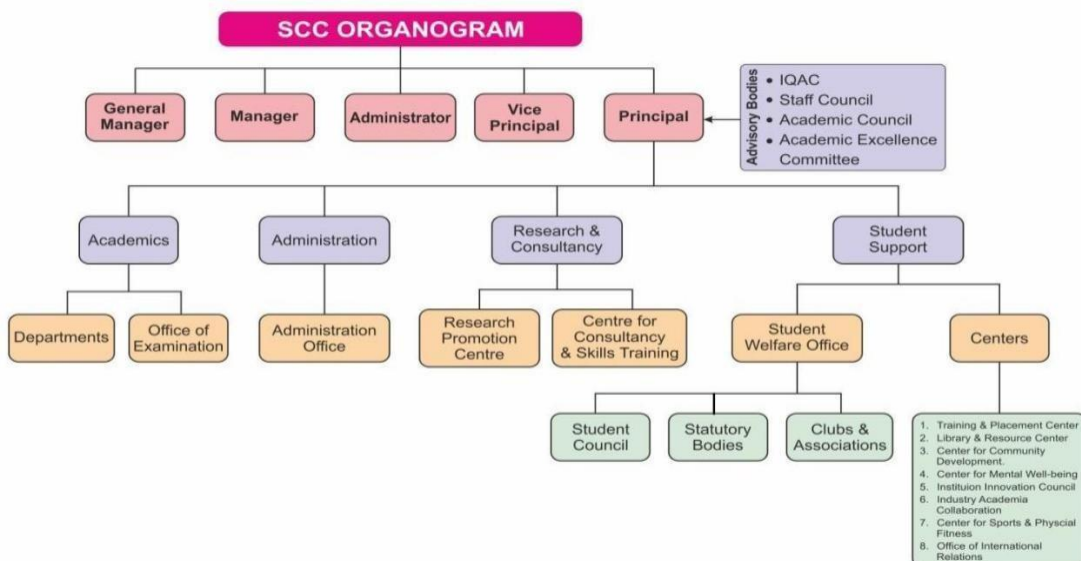

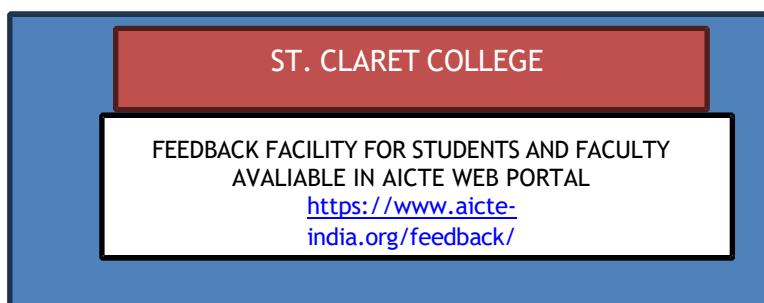
- **Establishment of Anti-Ragging Committee**
