1. Does all programs/courses were completed on time.	Yes
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2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.		St. Claret College was able to maintain equilibrium in regular studies seamlessly during the pandemic adopting the following measures: 1.Exclusive IT infrastructure for interactive live classrooms and video-conferencing was created. Licensed Zoom platforms with varied capacities were procured. Student Orientation, Conferences, webinars, FDPs, PDPs, Workshops, academic, cultural and literary fests were organized using 1000 and 500 user capacity IDs. In case of more than 1000 participants, You Tube Live streaming was used. 2.Google Meet and Zoom were used for online classes and mentoring. Google Classroom was used for uploading study materials, assigning and collecting assignments and also for uploading the Internal Exam Question Paper and collecting the Answer Scripts. 3.Internal Examination was conducted virtually through Google Meet, wherein the students were required to turn on their camera and write the answers in sheets under the observation of invigilator. The answer scripts were scanned and uploaded to the Google Classroom. 4.The Internet capacity of the existing ISP with a speed of 1000 Mbps was augmented with an additional alternate ISP with a speed of 1000 Mbps (Dedicated Fibre Line). 5.Google meet, Microsoft Teams, Cisco WebEx and Skype were also used for webinars, classroom interaction, expert lectures and training programmes. 6.During the offline and Online mode, provision was made for blended approach, where in students could attend classes both online and offline. Few Practical Classes of Online mode were recorded. The recorded sessions of those classes were made available to the students for future reference. 7.The library has a repository of e-books with remote access facility for faculty and students. The library has subscribed for N-list, Delnet and Mint book. Inlibnet and Delnet databases provided academic and research data to the students and faculty. 8.Students were also encouraged to take up Online MOOC Courses like NPTEL under SWAYAM and Coursera. Students were provided with online internships through Internshala training platform. St. Claret College has secured 1st Rank at the State level and 13th Rank at National level in the Internshala Annual Internship Rankings 2021.
