event was Mr. Chethan B, International Athlete. All the students and faculty members of SCC took part in various events and won exciting prizes.



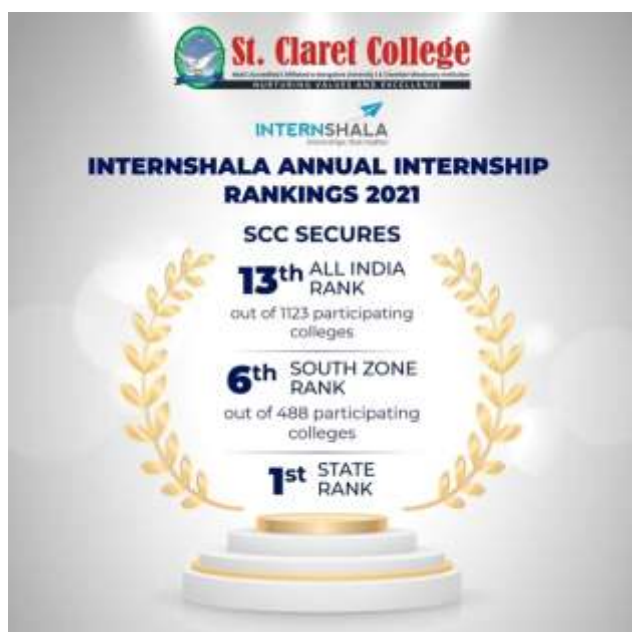


## Resonance 2022

**The Context of Claret Conference - 2022**
